

Summer Camp 2025 FAQ's

1. What is the “Al Shindagha Museum Summer Camp?”	Al Shindagha Museum Archaeology Adventure Summer Camp 2025 offers engaging experience for children aged 6-12 to venture on indoor archaeological exploration and exclusive behind-the-scenes access to a professional archaeologist's lab. Children will embark on a 5-day immersive expedition of interactive activities, guided explorations, archaeology challenge, metal casting, petroglyph workshops, and a fun-packed scavenger hunt.
2. What are the periods during which the summer camp is held?	The summer camp events take place over 5 days, from Monday to Friday. The first week is scheduled from 14–18 July Or The second week is scheduled from 21–25 July
3. What are the timings for the summer camp activities?	The camp begins welcoming children at 8:30 AM activities are held from 9:00 AM to 2:30 PM from Monday to Thursday, and on Fridays, the camp activities end at 12:30 PM.
4. What activities does the camp offer for children?	The summer camp offers a variety of hands-on and interactive archaeological activities that bring the past to life. Gain valuable insights from experienced archaeologists. A field trip to Restoration House, solve ancient puzzles in the archaeology challenge, create replicas in a metal casting session, craft symbolic art in petroglyph making, embark on a fun-packed museum scavenger hunt and so much more.
5. How can a child document their participation in the camp?	On the last day of the camp, children will receive a certificate for their participation during the summer camp, children can also take their toolkit as a souvenir, in addition they will be taking home some of the objects they created during the various interactive workshops during the camp.

<p>9. Who provides the materials for children during their participation in the activities?</p>	<p>The camp administration is responsible for providing all the materials that the child will use during the camp, and parents must inform the administration if their children are allergic to any of the possible items used, in anticipation of any emergency.</p>
<p>10. Is the transportation provided?</p>	<p>Yes, transportation is provided and included in the fees. Availability is limited to designated pick-up and drop-off points within Dubai.</p>

What should children bring when they arrive at the camp, and what type of clothing should they wear?</p>	<p>To ensure they have everything they need for this camp, we're pleased to inform you that your child/children will be provided with their archaeological tool kit and camp materials containing:</p>

12. What is the capacity for workshop participation?	Each group is limited to a maximum of 17 children to ensure enjoyment, and adherence to health and safety standards.
13. Can children be visited during their time at the camp?	<p>Parents/guardians are not allowed to be on the site throughout the camp day. However, they can purchase tickets to enter the museum and spend time in its various sections and pavilions. Whilst we appreciate campers' parents wanting to stop by, only children will be allowed inside the activity venues.</p> <p>We strongly encourage you to ask about their day after pick-up so they can share their experiences with you at that time!</p> <p>Al Shindagha Museum representatives are available to answer questions during drop-off and pick-up.</p>
14. Are medical services available at the campsite?	In the application of health and safety standards, the camp administration provides staff specialized in medical support who are ready to intervene in emergencies, and our team will communicate with parents immediately in the event of any medical situation.
15. Who supervises the children during their time at the camp?	Specialized Cultural Guide will supervise the training workshops to ensure children receive relevant experiences and knowledge.
16. Can the child participate only in specific activities in the camp?	The camp activities are designed to be presented to the child in an integrated manner over a week, and therefore the child cannot participate in certain activities only.

17. Can participation be canceled and fees refunded after registration?	Participation cannot be canceled, and fees cannot be refunded after registration.
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
