

## Al Shindagha Museum Map

Al Shindagha Museum is situated in the historic Al Shindagha Neighbourhood - a neighbourhood of over 162 historic houses that witnessed the growth of modern Dubai.

The museum is divided into 22 pavilions spread over 80 houses, each one exploring a different aspect of Dubai's unique cultural heritage.

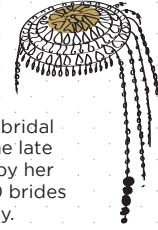


## THINGS TO EXPLORE

Be inspired by Dubai's rich craft heritage and have a go at traditional weaving and embroidery with our interactive exhibits.



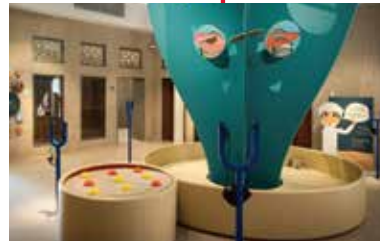
### Perfume House

Ferry stop: Al Ghubaiba Ferry Terminal
